Why do the Limitless Pioneers Gap Year?

Many take a gap year for life experience, gaining important skills along the way. During the Limitless Pioneers Gap Year, students experience the adventure of pioneering something new, learn what it takes to launch a new ministry, make lifelong friends, receive high quality training, experience more of God and discover the dynamic purpose of investing in the next generation.

During this gap year students learn more about themselves and many practical, transferable life skills that come with being part of a positive and successful team. People skills, budgeting, planning and implementing events, inter-personal communication as well as inter-organisational skills along with many other valuable life and work know-how which are valuable in navigating a full and significant life.

What is it?

Limitless Pioneers is an exciting gap year program focussed on pioneering new youth ministries across the UK through schools work, detached youth work and evangelistic initiatives, in partnership with local churches.

It begins with a team training camp at Limitless HQ before launching into youth ministry, joining with teams based at partnering churches. These teams will receive training throughout the year.

Those on the Limitless Pioneers gap year will experience the adventure of pioneering new ministries, receive training from some the UK's most inspiring leaders, make life long friends, grow in their gifts and deepen their faith in God.

How does it work?

The Limitless Pioneers Gap Year is an 11 month long programme, running from the start of September to mid July. The team, led by the course leader, are placed in a region of the UK to serve and partner with more than one church in close proximity.

You will live with a carefully chosen family from the local church who will help you to feel at home in your new community.

The cost of Limitless Pioneers Gap Year is only £2,500, which includes your accommodation, food & training!

All intern holidays will be in line with school calendar holidays.
